

5K Course: Accurate 5K Run/Walk.

Start on trail just below Museum Village. Head west on Heritage Trail towards Chester and turn around at Oxford Junction. Course will be well supported. Scenic paved trail nestled in central Orange County's rural splendor. Last Lap finish inside Museum Village with its historic shops open for business and demonstration.

Directions:

From Points East - NYS Thruway North to Exit 16 (Harriman, Route 17). Route 17, West 4 miles to exit 129 (Museum Village Road) Left at the end of exit ramp. Left onto Museum Village Road. Left on Route 17M. Parking lot is 1/4 mile on left.

From Points West - Route 17, East to exit 129 (Museum Village Road). Right at the end of the exit ramp. Right on Museum Village Road. Left at Route 17M. Parking lot is 1/4 mile on left.

Milagros Davis enjoyed running. She chased after life the same way. Weeks before her passing, she ran how her funeral was going to be conducted and the party that would be held immediately after. She loved running for causes. She appeared in a photograph in the Poughkeepsie Journal, Mid-Hudson, in an article that portrayed the role social workers like herself were pursuing in ensuring the health of migrant workers by conducting an aerobics class for farm workers. She worked in many different areas where someone with her inner strength and compassion was desperately needed. When she ran, she ran with everything she had. That was true to the final moments. Her passing on May 14, 2015 left a big hole in the hearts of all who knew her and had the fortunate opportunity to either work with her or be served by her. Her running extended to advancing herself through her personal pursuit of higher education. Even months before her passing, she was talking about going back to school for her Masters.
